### Stand-off ruling is there to see

Thank you for coverage of the questions raised by the association at the full council meeting (Row over quarry extension, March 24). May I set the record straight.

In replying to a question, the cabinet member for finance and support services agreed that people should be treated equally and stated that no planning application had ever been submitted or approved for 150 metres stand-off from buildings.

Available for viewing on the council's website is Planning Application 2118/00 for gravel extraction on Aldborough Hall Farm registered on August 2, 2000, where it is clearly stated: "Increase in stand-off to 150m from rear of properties on Applegarth Drive and Bawdsey Avenue to proposed gravel extraction face" as one of the conditions of approval for that application.
