Community group gives councillors green belt tour

Councillors strolled around the green belt in Aldborough Hatch and visited several community sites, including an orchard being restored for cider making, on Saturday.

The Aldborough Hatch Defence Association met with councillors Debbie Kaur-Thiara and John Howard to walk around the area's greenest spots.

Ron Jeffries, chairman of the group, said: "The councillors saw for themselves some of the issues giving concern on the newly-opened permissive bridleway, such as the brambles which could trip walkers unless treated, and the fact that the bridleway leads from Aldborough Road North to nowhere."
